

Seniors save on home renovations

our next renovation could qualify for money back if you are 65 years or older, or live with someone who is. The Healthy Homes Renovation Tax Credit is designed to help seniors with the costs of improving safety and accessibility in the home.

If you qualify, you can claim up to \$10,000 worth of eligible home improvements on your next tax return. The amount of money you get back for these expenses is calculated as 15 per cent of the eligible expenses you claim. For example, if you spend and then claim \$10,000 worth of eligible expenses, you could get \$1,500 back.

Your income doesn't matter; seniors and their family members at all income levels are eligible.

Some examples of eligible expenses include:

- certain renovations to permit a first-floor occupancy or secondary suite for a senior
- grab bars and related reinforcements around the toilet, tub and shower
- handrails in corridors
- wheelchair ramps, stair/wheelchair lifts and elevators
- walk-in bathtubs and wheel-in showers
- comfort height toilets



Seniors at all income levels can qualify for a Healthy Homes Renovation Tax Credit

- widening passage doors
- lowering existing counters/cupboards
- installing adjustable counters/cupboards
- light switches and electrical outlets placed in accessible locations
- door locks that are easy to operate
- lever handles on doors and taps, instead of knobs
- pull-out shelves under counter to enable work from a seated position

- non-slip flooring
- a hand-held shower on an adjustable rod or high-low mounting brackets
- additional light fixtures at home and exterior entrances
- swing clear hinges on doors to widen doorways
- creation of knee space under the basin to enable use from a seated position (and insulation of any hot-water pipes)
- relocation of tap to front or side for easier access
- hands-free taps
- motion-activated lighting
- touch-and-release drawers and cupboards
- automatic garage door openers

KEEPING THE HEAT IN...AND OUT

Weatherstripping saves on heating and A/C costs



Hiring a professional to caulk and weatherstrip your home can cut air leakage by up to 50 per cent and save you up to 30 per cent on your heating/cooling costs. Armed with specialized equipment and testing devices, a professional can pinpoint leakage and check and repair existing caulking and weatherstripping.

The most common sources of air leaks in the home are in the basement, through exterior walls and around electrical outlets. Air can also escape from windows, pipes, vents, exterior doors and fireplaces.

Caulking can be applied indoors and outdoors. On the interior, caulking is used to plug cracks, joints and other leakage points to prevent heated air from escaping. On the exterior, caulking will protects joints against rain and weather, but allow moisture to escape.

Weatherstripping is used in joints which need freedom to move, such as between doors and windows and frames.
