hat exactly are you supposed to do the day you find your basement flooded?

Plumbing emergencies can be scary, particularly as the cost of water damage to your home and other property can be more expensive than the plumbing repairs themselves. If you find yourself facing a plumbing emergency, you need to call a professional plumber right away, but you should first take action to mitigate any damage to your plumbing or the rest of your home.

or appliances in your home. Ensure all family members who live in the home also know where it is, and label it with instructions. It's important that this valve works when you need it to – spray the valve stem with lubricant periodically so it operates smoothly in an emergency

Turn Your Water Heater Off

If your water heater is gas you need to turn the gas to the heater off or turn the unit itself off if you have turned the water off from the main valve. Once the water

> is off, pressure and hot water build up in the unit. If you don't do this, there is a chance your water heater could burst, causing other problems. It could also simply overheat. and when the water is used, someone could get badly burned when turning on the hot water for the first time.



If the flooding is severe, turn off the electricity to the room before entering, and unplug all appliances. If the water has risen to or above the outlets, contact your hydro company immediately to shut off the power to prevent shocks or electrocution.

Who to Call

Make a list of emergency numbers, including your Homeservice Club membership number, and keep it in an easily accessible place for all members of the household. If you have a security system, be sure to include the monitoring station phone-in details.

While You're Waiting

Now that you've called in the cavalry, you can start mitigating any further damage to your property. Remove as much water as possible by mopping or using a wet/dry shop-vacuum. Shut the Water Off

In almost all plumbing emergencies, the first thing you should do is stop water from continuing to flow. Know where your main water shutoff valve is, and know where the shutoffs are for individual fixtures
