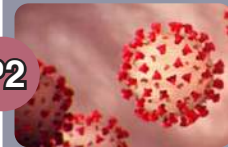

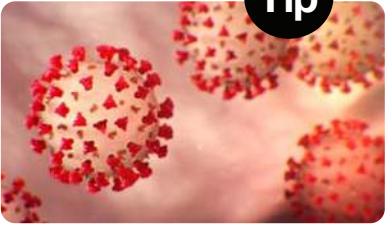

COUNTERTOPS

STYLE FILES - COUNTERTOP MATERIALS

When you're planning a new kitchen, you face many different choices and one of the biggest is the countertop. You'll be preparing, chopping, cutting, mixing, spilling, cleaning and maybe eating on it many times every day, so appearance is important but not everything. Fortunately, countertops are available in many different materials to suit your cooking and cleaning style. And, the range of finishes is huge so you're sure to find the right mix of style and function.

Concrete

Custom and poured in place, the final product is only as good as the installation. Concrete chips and scratches easily, and can develop hairline cracks. Topical sealers can protect it against stains but not heat, and most penetrating sealers can handle heat but not stains.

Laminate

Inexpensive and stylish options with decorative edges abound. These countertops resist stains and heat pretty well, but cutting directly on it and using abrasive cleaning agents can mar the surface.

Marble

Marble takes on a patina over time which some consider beautiful but others see as marred. Small nicks and scratches can be polished out, but marble chips easily and needs to be resealed periodically. On sealed marble most stains are easily wiped away with water.

Limestone

Limestone resists heat well, but it nicks, cuts, and scratches easily, and even a high quality sealer can have trouble fending off stains. Make sure to blot spills immediately and periodically reseal.

Quartz

This mix of mineral, colour, and resin is meant to mimic stone but is more durable and requires less maintenance, making it a good choice for a kitchen that gets a lot of use. Hot pots, serrated knives, abrasive pads, and most stains are no match for quartz.

Granite

The real deal. Each stone slab is unique. Heat, cuts, and scratching won't harm it, but corners and edges can chip; let a pro repair take care of those. Polished and matte finishes resist most stains when properly sealed, a process that should be repeated periodically.

Soapstone

It's not as common as granite—and it's stunning. It resists heat damage, and small scratches can be sanded. But it nicks, cuts, and scratches easily, and some tough stains won't wash away.

Bamboo

It sounds crazy but it's eco-friendly, it adds warmth, and it looks great (at first), but it's easily stained, scorched, and nicked. Check if you can use the variety you've chosen near a sink, as excessive moisture can warp some varieties.
